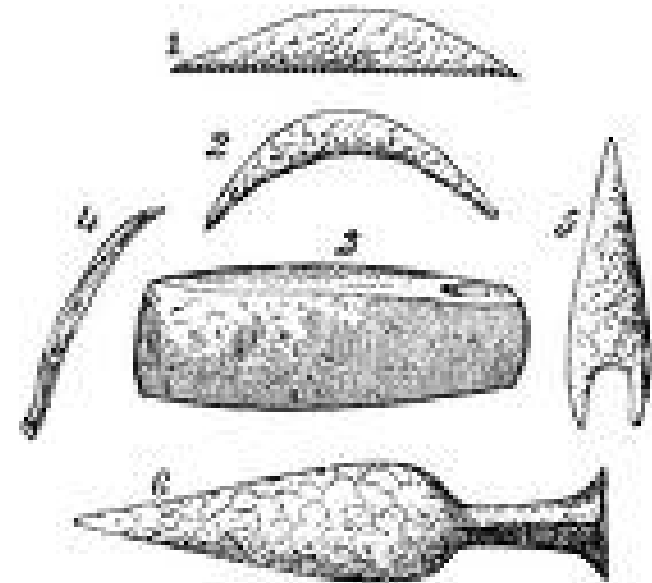


- The system of ages is a way to measure periods of time**

Bronze Age tools




Iron Age tools
